Topic

We have started our new Topic on Mini beasts this week. The children have been naming and sorting different insects into groups by looking carefully at their features. We have painted some wonderful pictures of ladybirds, butterflies and caterpillars. In the garden we have been bug explorers searching for worms and snails and making homes for them to keep them dry from the rain!
