Weekly Learning

Information about some of the things we will be learning in the week beginning 27th June 2022

English

Through our story this week 'Once upon a Dragon's fire' we will be talking all about the emotions felt by the characters within the story.

We will be encouraging discussions where children will need to articulate and justify their answers, form arguments and say their opinions. We will be recording what we think ensuring we are using capital letters and full stops for each sentence.

We continue to work on our spellings and handwriting daily - these are good skills to rehearse at home regularly alongside hearing your child read.

Maths

This week in maths we will be weighing. We will understand mass by comparing weights using balance scales. We will learn about reading scales in grams and kilograms. Can you do some cooking and measure out some ingredients at home? Using maths in real life contexts is the best way to build our children's understanding.

We will answer questions such as: Are larger objects always heavier than smaller objects? How many grams in a kilogram? What is heavier/lighter than a Kilogram?

RE: This week, children will learn about how God gave us the world as a treasure for us to look after. We will talk about and share ways that we can look after our world. We will also learn about how we are treasures to God. We will talk about how he treasures us. For example, God gives us water to live and family to love us. The children will then paint their own pictures showing how God treasures them.



PE: This week we will be learning how to maintain balance whilst doing a mini-front support position. We will explore doing this whilst also pointing to the ceiling, as well as also placing a cone on our backs and taking it off with the other hand. We will then also learn how to do a mini-back support position and attempt to put a cone on our tummy and take it off with the other hand.

Please come to school in PE clothes instead of uniform on these days.




Music



This week we will be listening to the "The Diary Of A Fly" by Béla Bartók, an orchestral composition from the 20th Century, and will then discuss the following:

- What can you hear?
- How does the music make you feel?
- How old do you think the music is?
- Does the music tell a story?
- Do you like the music and why?

ICT



This week we will learn how to upload a sound from a bank of sounds into the Sounds section. We will learn how to record our own sound and upload it into the Sounds section. We will then create our own tune using the sounds which we have added to the Sounds section.

P.S.H.E. (Personal, Social, Health Education)



This week we will be learn how to keep money safe and why this is important. We will discuss the fact that if people want to buy much more expensive items, such as a car or a house, they will need to save money for a long period of time and keep that money secure.
