


At Pre-School we have agreed 'Golden Rules' that keep us safe and happy. We will think about how following these rules makes us 'Superstars' and how good this makes us feel.

Maths Subitising 1-5


Focus Shape- cuboids, cubes

Our Special Words



Always- When you do something every time or all the time, you are always doing it.
