Go to Purple Mash – Mathematics – Measure – Time looking at hours, half hours, days of the week and months of the year.



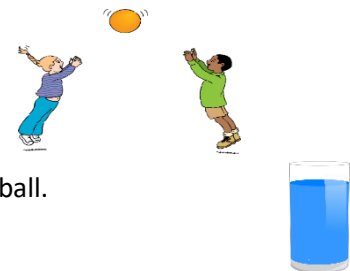
Music
