
Weekly Learning

R.E. Holidays and Holy Days

We will learn about the different reasons we celebrate on special occasions and about 'feast' days in the Christian year such as Easter, Christmas, Pentecost, Candlemas and Saints Days. We will make cards to mark these celebrations as 'Holy Days'.




We will read a story from the Bible about one of the times Jesus met with his friends after the resurrection when he promised to send them the gift of the Holy Spirit.

Aiming High

Our Big Questions this week are:
What is a positive learning attitude?
How can a positive learning attitude help us?



We will think about what we need to focus on to become positive learners such as

- trying our best even in challenging work
- learning from mistakes
- enjoying the challenge of new learning
- being determined
- knowing different ways we can get help



We will identify the kinds of learning we find easier or more challenging. We will think of a time we have achieved a challenging task or skill. We will think about how we were able to do this and the importance of being

positive.

Maths

We will learn about **Making Equal Groups**

- 1) What is $4 + 4$?
- 2) What is $5 + 5$?
- 3) What does this symbol mean? =

4) Which of these balance scales shows both objects have an **equal** mass?



We will find out more about what the word equal means and use counting equipment to share out different amounts of objects into equal groups.

Then we will explore how repeated addition can show how the groups are combined to make the total.

English

We will begin to learn how to improve our sentences by re-reading them and making changes or corrections.
