

We are **Exploring Different Ways to Add and Subtract** such as:

Using Numberlines to jump forwards and backwards




Finding Missing Numbers in Number Sentences

Practising how to use our own Log In information to access the school computers and the Purple Mash website independently continues. Learning can be supported online with Purple Mash at home.




Music
