


Information about some of the things we will be learning in the **Week Beginning 13th June**

R.E. Being Sorry

We continue thinking about what it means to be sorry and how and when we should say this.

We read the story *I'm Sorry* by Sam McBratney and discuss the characters actions and feelings. Then we reflect on our own experiences of making mistakes and being sorry.



We begin exploring what it means to say sorry to God for breaking his rules and how this affects how we live.

PHSE It's My Body

We start our new topic by talking about the choices we have over what happens to our bodies and how we can protect ourselves. It is so important that we know that we all have the right to feel safe and happy and that we know what to do when we do not.




We talk about which problems are 'little' ones that we can solve ourselves, which are 'tricky' which may need some help and which are 'serious' that we must ask for help with.

We learn about what parts of the body are OK for others to see and touch, and which ones are 'private'. In this way we understand how we can protect ourselves from harm and learn who we can trust to help us if we are upset or worried about what happens to us.

Maths

We learn about **Fractions of Shapes and Sets of Objects.**



Find a half

There are 12 bees.

Half of 12 is 6

We take shapes and explore folding and cutting them to find **2 equal parts that we call half.**

Then we take groups of objects and share them into 2 equal groups so that there is half in each group.

Next we take shapes and learn that if we share them into **4 equal parts we find quarters.**

Then we use groups of objects and share them into 4 equal groups so that there is a quarter in each group.

Try finding $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{4}$ parts of food or groups of objects at home!


English

We revisit how to improve our sentences by learning about different types of words and using them to make our writing interesting:

nouns – people, places and things (boy, cat, table, sky, names of people / places)

verbs – doing or action words (run, sit, play, drive)

adjectives – describing words (good, yucky, soft, sunny, scary, names of colours)



We begin work on a new story: **The Queen's Knickers**. We will learn to retell it by recalling the key events and adding actions to these. Then we will use story maps to tell it to one another. We will also look in the story for different types of words and discuss their meanings.

We also practise the songs we are performing at the Father's Day assembly On Friday.




P.E.

Please come to school in P.E. Clothes on P.E. days which are


Tuesdays and Thursdays for both classes.

Topic – Science

We are learning about **Plants** and will be doing a Plant Hunt around the school grounds.
